



Dr. PETER PAVEL KLASINC, studied history and history of art at the University of Ljubljana where he graduated. His first job was in the Historical Archives Ptuj (Zgodovinski arhiv Ptuj, Slovenia), where he was director from 1972 until 1976. He joined The Regional Archives Maribor (Pokrajinski arhiv Maribor, Slovenia) in 1976, where he held the post of director between 1982 and 1994. He conducted his postgraduate studies in Zagreb, where he achieved his master's degree in 1986 on maintenance and preservation of archives and records at The University of Zagreb. In 1991 he received his doctorate from the same university on the topic of preservation of traditional and new media information in the archives. In 1997 he achieved position of scientific and archival councillor. In addition to regular coursework he performed professional training in the archives, archival services and archives of other similar institutions in England, Austria, Italy, Germany, the Netherlands, France, Canada, the United States, China, Hungary, Czech Republic, Slovakia, Poland and Scandinavian countries in the field of archival expertise and technical problems of introducing new information technology in archival work, external archival service etc. He participates as a visiting lecturer with the Faculty of Arts, University of Zagreb, where he was awarded the title of research associate in 1996. He has also cooperated with the Faculty of Arts, University of Tuzla. As an archivist he has been engaged in various expert committees. He was appointed Consultant Roundtables Archives Council (CITRA / ICA), he was a regular member of the Professional Section of Archives (SPA / ICA) in the International Archives Council, based in Paris (MAS-ICA) and an observer member of the International Committee on construction and equipment of the MAS (CBQ / ICA). He is a member of the International Committee on Buildings and Equipment in Temperate Climates in the International Archives Council (ICA-CBTE). He is the Head of the International Institute for Archival Science at the University of Maribor since 1992, Maribor Archive Society, President and Vice President of Slovene heraldic society *Heraldica Slovenica* and a member of the Commission to Evaluate Proposals for a New Flag and Emblem of the National Assembly of the Republic of Slovenia. He has published some four hundred professional, scientific and archival practical and theoretical papers in Slovene and other foreign languages in numerous national and international scientific archival journals.
