



**Dr AZEM KOŽAR**, studied at the University of Prishtina, where he also completed his masters degree in modern history in 1980. He acquired his first Ph.D in 1998 at the University of Zagreb on archival material protection in war circumstances and also in 2008 on topic of Tuzla and its surroundings during Turkish and Austro-Hungarian administration between 1870 and 1890. He acquired position of archival councillor in 1995. He worked as a teacher, held a position of a headmaster, was a curator at the Museum of Eastern Bosnia in Tuzla, director of Historical Archives of Tuzla, and has been working at the University of Tuzla since 1993, currently holding position of associate professor. He has been head of History department for several years, Pro dean for curriculum and student support. He is currently a member of University of Tuzla senate and Faculty of Arts dean. He's been active as visiting professor at universities of Osijek, Bihać and Mostar, is a member of International Institute for Archival Science Trst-Maribor, chairman of Association of Historians of Tuzla and organising committee of international archival conference Archival Practice. He has published over 200 papers on archives and history.
