



Dr. VLADIMÍR OPĚLA, born 1938, finished his studies in University Brno in 1961. He started to work in Film Archive on 1.9.1965 as a technician. In November 1989 Vladimír Opěla was elected as a chief of the Film Archive. On 1.1.1992 he was authorized as a new director of the Czech Film Institute. On V. Opěla's suggestion the Czech Film Institute was transformed to the National Film Archive/Národní filmový archiv on 1.7.1992. Vladimír Opěla is a member of the Scientific Archive Council of Czech Republic, a member of the Executive Committee of FIAF (1991 – 1997, 2005 - , Vice-President 1993 – 1997, 2007 - 2011). He was a member of FIAF Preservation and FIAF Cataloguing Commissions and a co-founder of ACE. From 11.11.2011 he works in NFA as the Curator.
