



**Dr. SNEŽANA PEJOVIĆ**, professor of literature and archivist, was born in Kotor, (Montenegro). She graduated from Belgrade University, (Department for Yugoslav and World literature). She continued her studies on a postgraduate course at the Philological faculty, at the Department for Science of literature. Since 1981 she has been working at State Archives – Kotor Historical archives as an archivist who deals with processing of oldest archival material kept in Montenegro (from 1309). Currently she is the Head of Kotor Historical Archives. She is included in many projects concerning the development of archival profession as well as projects of research and publishing of archival material, working with many cultural and scientific institutions, government bodies, etc. in Montenegro, former Yugoslavia and in abroad. (For example, like a member of the Working Groups of the Ministry of Culture of Montenegro for making study of the state of archival service in Montenegro as well as for the preparation the Law and series of archival bylaws on archival activities.). She participated with papers in many international conferences, symposia, etc. in Montenegro, around former Yugoslavia and abroad. She took part in the realization of more than 20 archival exhibitions. In addition, she obtains three international grants for broadening of her professional knowledge. From 1999 she became one of the founders of the professional NGO: *Centre for the preservation and presentation of Kotor's documentary heritage »Notar«* and she is its president, (<http://www.cdknotar.org>). Besides being a regular member in the International Institute of Archival Sciences Trieste-Maribor – IIASTM, she is the representative of the State Archives of Montenegro in the International Centre for Archival Research - ICARUS. In addition, she was an active member of some societies and organizations in the former Yugoslavia and she is still a member of some significant organizations in the country and abroad (for example, member of the Council of Montenegrin Cinematheque, member and one of the founders of the South East European Heritage Network (<http://www.seheritage.org>), the member of Steering Committee of the Community of Italians in Montenegro, etc.). Until now she has published about 100 bibliographic items in the country and abroad.
